

Pao Joute, pioneer missionary, and founder of HPWM, Tripura, India:

Salute (heartfelt greetings) you all, in the name of whom we all stood together from our own places and under the loving shadow of His peaceful wings. Safety and secured we are as His eternal treasures, and so valuable that we are bought with His blood, and what a responsible we have in Him as we all have the mind to do His will. Great privilege He offered to all and blessed to everyone who took advantage of that opportunity by which nobody could obtain with their titles and degrees, wealth and knowledge, but a poor man

who humbled himself and accepted His unseen hope by faith alone, like you and me, halleluiah, Praise be to His precious name.

Pao heard the gospel cry in his 20th and accepted the forgiveness of his sin when he confessed to God and Jesus Christ to be his personal Saviour and Lord. The following year took he baptism by immersion.

Vision: The day he was saved in to the family of God, and his Saviour Jesus Christ, he commits his life for the lost and plan to go theological study and missionary work thereon. His saying was "Going without we cannot reach, faith without we cannot go, going without vision is hopeless, but all these things can only fulfill and fruitful in the Charity (Love) of God, through His Son Jesus Christ". (Matt. 28:19, 20; Heb. 11:1; John 9:4)

Strategy: Pao firstly did not aim city and town where mostly and easily people reached there, instead corner of the city, town, and in the village of hillside areas. There the gospel was reached yes, but they were not touched by God's word. Reached and Touched has their own meaning. May be reached but no guarantee of touched by it. Village people are poor and danger of life, so must reached and preached first, and from them (new believers) gospel should go to towns and cities.

Preparation: His most hatred Job was Army, but when the time cometh, his hardship domestic condition push him and compelled him, and spent all most all his young life there. God gave many spiritual sons and daughters in the Army among his friends' children. He partly served the Lord and the government together, so he at last got voluntary retirement in compassionate ground after several attempt in 16 years and 3 month service.

Pao married to Ms. Veizaching (Chingbawi) d/o of S. Tualzalian and Thienkhokim, after 9 years of service in the Army in 1996. The following year his wife also got her good result in her secular degree.

As Pao took the retirement in 2004 April, he left his wife daughter at home, and went South India in the month of July to study theology with theory and practical he spent 7 years. Fortunately in the middle of his study he took his wife to study theology too, and his wife too completed her BRE.

Purpose: To evangelize in a village where the gospel doesn't preach or share. Plan church and teach the word of God, Bible study and making disciples. Children's ministry, develop children through education.

Mission: The Lord blesses the ministries since its inception from 2015, till 2021, with three churches in South Tripura among Reang and Jamatia, one fellowship among student community, six orphan children, and one primary school.

Equipping Indigenous Ministries (EIM): One year after entering in the mission field, the Lord knows the needs of His people and sent Daddy, Dr. C.V. John (Evangelist) Director and Founder of EIM, a visionary leader to extend vision for the Lord. EIM enlarge the ministry border with us from 2016, and took all the crystal guidance, and become the backbone of HPWM. EIM has no border line for the gospel ministry, may God blesses and increase their numbers to spread, propagate the good news of eternal life to the whole world until Christ come.
